



Hotspot (Sprint LG K3)

Getting Started

A mobile hotspot is a device that provides wi-fi in areas that do not have wired Internet. This quick sheet provides directions on connecting a device to a Sprint LG K3 hotspot.

Be aware: this device is a smartphone—it has phone call and text messaging capability!

Unboxing

The hotspot box contains the phone, a power adapter (with power cord), and a sheet of paper with important information:


1. Phone number for the device.
2. Account PIN for the device.
3. Answer to security question for Sprint support.
4. Sprint support phone number.

Power On/Off


To power on the phone, hold the power button for at least 5 seconds. To power off the phone, hold the power button for a few seconds and then tap “Power off”.

Turn On Hotspot Service

1. Swipe up from the bottom of the screen all the way to the top of the screen to unlock the device.
2. Swipe down from the top of the screen. Look to the top right of the screen, find and tap the gear icon:



3. Scroll down the list, find and tap “Tethering”:




4. Tap “Wi-Fi hotspot”:



5. Tap “Set up Wi-Fi hotspot”:



6. Wi-Fi name and Password are safe to change (the hotspot may not function properly if you change the other settings):





Hotspot (Sprint LG K3)

You can see the wi-fi password by tapping the “Show password” check box. Tap “Save” when you’re finished.


7. Tap the switch to turn the hotspot service on/off:



Connect a Laptop to the Hotspot

1. Power on the phone and turn on the hotspot service.
2. Connect your device to the hotspot’s wi-fi signal.

Mac laptop example:



3. Your device will prompt you to enter the password for the hotspot’s wi-fi signal. Step 6 from the previous section shows how to see the hotspot’s wi-fi password. Enter this password into the prompt on your device.

Connect an iPad to the Hotspot

1. Find the “Settings” App and tap it to open it:



2. On the left side of the screen find and tap “Wi-Fi”.
3. On the right side of the screen, make sure the Wi-Fi switch is on (green). If it is not, tap it to switch it on.

4. The “Networks” section is a list of wi-fi signals detected by the iPad. Find the hotspot’s wi-fi signal and tap it to connect.
5. Your device will prompt you to enter the password for the hotspot’s wi-fi signal. Step 6 from the previous section shows how to see the hotspot’s wi-fi password. Enter this password into the prompt on your device. Look to the upper right and tap “Join”.
6. To disconnect from a wi-fi signal:
 - A. Tap the “i” button to the right of the signal.
 - B. Tap the “Forget This Network” button.
